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Criteria for Requesting Privileges For Carotid Stenting:

Initial Requests: To be eligible to request clinical privileges in carotid artery stenting, an applicant must meet the following minimum threshold criteria:

- Basic education: *MD or DO*
- Minimum formal training: Applicants must be Board Certified or Board Eligible (must pass Boards within timeframe required by ABMS) or completed an ACGME/AOA-accredited vascular surgery, interventional cardiovascular medicine, interventional or neuroradiology fellowship program that included training in stent placement procedures.
- Previous Privilege Utilization: Applicants must have full peripheral vascular angiographic interventional privileges.

Course Work: Successful completion of One (1) Category I Carotid Stent Course.

-Required previous experience: Applicants must be able to demonstrate that they have performed at least 30 diagnostic cerebral angiograms. In addition, applicants must be able to demonstrate that they have performed 25 carotid artery stent procedures in the past 3 years. For at least half of these procedures, the applicant must have been the primary operator.

Reappointment: For renewal of privileges at the time of reappointment, every 2 years, documentation of **a minimum** five (5) cases.
